

**Results Based Management and Performance Measurement Training Program at CIDA. A workshop designed to support the Association of Universities and Community Colleges (AUCC)**

RBM plays an important role in realizing Canada's Official Development Assistance (ODA) goal to support sustainable development in developing countries by addressing six ODA priorities: Basic Human Needs; Gender Equality; Infrastructure Services; Human Rights, Democracy and Good Governance; Private Sector Development; and, the Environment.

This workshop was held in October 2005 as a one-day session, a compressed version of IDEA's three-day Advanced Results-Based Management Workshop series. Organizations currently engaged in management of CIDA programs and services use this capacity building activity to learn how to effectively apply the full cycle RBM requirements which include: planning, delivery and reporting.

The workshop has been successfully delivered to more than 1000 participants in Canada and internationally, including China, India, Thailand, Vietnam, Brazil, Egypt, Jordan, Syria, Bosnia, Romania. Past participants include CIDA staff, CIDA Project Support Units, World Bank Project Implementation Units, UNDP, UNRWA, Government Ministries in the countries mentioned, as well as Canadian and international project staff.
